FROM THE DESK OF..... BISHOP NATHAN BAXTER

Dear Sisters & Brothers in Christ;

Members of the Commission on Ministry, invited advisors and two persons who are in the early stages of discerning their call to ministry in the Church will gather with me this Wednesday and Thursday for the Bishop's Advisory Conference on Ministry (BACOM). Please pray for us as we come together at the Sisters of Saints Cyril and Methodius Villa Sacred Heart in Danville for a time of fellowship, prayer and discernment. This is an exciting time for our church and our beloved Diocese. We have over 20 persons at different stages of discernment at this time. On Sunday, October 31st at 4:00pm six of those persons will be ordained to the Diaconate. Among the current postulants, we have three who entered Episcopal seminaries this Fall for full time studies towards ordination to the priesthood. And we have a full class of persons attending the School of Christian Studies in preparation for entering the formal discernment process.

God is surely working amongst us. Remember, God calls us is many different ways. Many of the Ordinands have shared that they best acknowledged God's call to ministry through their friends and colleagues at church suggesting that they pursue such a call. Might that person be you? Are you hearing the gentle nudging of God's still small voice? Or might you be the manifestation of that voice for someone you know?

The School of Christian Studies has several different courses, both short and longer term that are available to all persons in the diocese. Courses that can help you to discern whether the ministry God is calling you to is along the path of ordination or as a lay person in your community. Canon Kate Harrigan is happy to share information about these opportunities at the School, so please contact her if you have any questions.

So, pray for us please, at BACOM, that we may follow God's leading as we discern with our brother and sister about their journey of discernment. And pray in your own heart and your own parish, that you might hear God's voice in your life, and follow where he leads, whether it be to ministry (either lay or ordained) or whether it be to help nudge someone towards the path God is preparing for them.
