This fee covers approximately half of the transportation, lodging, food, and programming costs. The Diocese will provide a matching grant to cover the remainder of the costs. Youth are expected to participate in fundraising activities to cover costs.

#### Who is Eligible? Any youth in grades 9-12 who:

- **Participates** in the life of his or her home congregation
- Has his or her **priest's recommendation**
- Is ready, willing and able to be a full participant in the EYE activities.

Any adult **over the age of 21** who:

- Has **experience** leading youth trips
- Is ready, willing, and able to be a full participant in EYE activities
