**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that this 144<sup>th</sup> Convention of the diocese of Central Pennsylvania embraces, encourages, supports and affirms the leadership and ministry of our Provisional Bishop as the Chief Priest of the Diocese; his work with Program Groups and Commissions, churches and individuals; and his ministry of shepherding God's people through present challenges and opportunities and into God's future.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that we enthusiastically receive his address to this 144<sup>th</sup> Convention, and pledge to reflectively, innovatively, and collaboratively implement the recommendations and vision contained therein. Specifically:

- 1. To move forward in a process of mutual formation, addressing the health of ourselves, our parishes and our diocese, as we prepare to welcome our next bishop.
- 2. To own the work of healing and community, taking responsibility for our own actions.
- 3. To use all available mission and ministry opportunities to reconcile ourselves with God and each other.
- 4. That we be accountable, transparent, and self-aware to promote healing in our diocese.
- 5. To pray the Scriptures with intentionality, co-operate, see the world beyond ourselves, sacrifice for the sake of our ministry, and stay within our roles.
- 6. To embrace the work of reform, promoting gospel principles, and living in to communal norms.

The Committee on the Bishop's Address respectfully request that this 144<sup>th</sup> Convention accept and adopt these resolutions in response to our Bishop's Address.
