Continuing Education: Suggested—18 Continued Education Units (CEU) (18 contact hours) per year

Title III: Canon 7, sec. 5. The Bishop and Commission on Ministry shall require and provide for the continuing education of Deacons and keep a record of such education.

Title III: Canon 9, sec. 1. The Bishop and Commission on Ministry shall require and provide for the continuation education of Priests and keep a record of such education.

Educational Competencies

Theological / Academic Reading and studying the Holy Scriptures, and seeking knowledge of the Word of God and the Sacraments to be in mission and ministry.

Building the family of God through prophetic and pastoral Leadership that serves the church now and in the future

Personal Attending to the patterns of one's life in accordance to the teachings of Christ.



What is a CONTINUING EDUCATION UNIT (CEU)?

Defined—The standard for one CEU in the Diocese of CPA is approximately one contact hour between the instructor and student in a learning situation designed for clergy and/or church communities.
