Diocesan Communications for 2018:

A Sycamore House Service Corps member was hired in September of 2018 to manage all aspects of diocesan events until July 2019. The service Corps member stayed on diocesan staff until January 31, 2019 and a part-time Interim Coordinator was hired to replace her.

Ms. Brenda Scott was also hired as the part-time Major Diocesan Events planner to manage Diocesan Convention and Clergy Conference for 2019.

Diocesan Digest and Bishop's Message

- The Diocesan Digest, Letters from Bishop Scanlan (Pastoral Letters) and the Clergy Digest continue to be delivered monthly electronically through Constant Contact, the e-mail marketing software.
- Special messages are also periodically e-mailed to the diocese and select groups such as parish treasurers, vestry secretaries, wardens and parish administrators.
- DIOCPA Youth e-news. Once a month, a diocesan youth e-newsletter is e-mailed to the master list.

Diocesan Website

Canon Alexis Guszick is the diocesan webmaster and designs and maintains the diocesan website, www.diocesecpa.org. The website continues to grow in number of visitors and on top of installing ssl certificates to make the website more secure, she has installed google analytics and reviews monthly traffic reports.

Diocesan Social Media

Diocesan social media continues to grow at a record rate. The diocese uses various social media platforms such as Facebook, Instagram and Twitter to connect with social media users internationally to communicate diocesan vision, happenings, news and latest events. Facebook alone has increased by over 1,000 followers since 2017. The diocesan social media platforms have become so busy that Canon Guszick uses Hootsuite for scheduling posts for news and events.

Podcasts, Videos, Livestream feeds and Sound bites

The diocesan Communications office produces podcasts, videos, livestreams and sound bite recordings to upload to the diocesan website and social media.

Digital Faith

In 2018, the diocesan Communications office performed an efficacy study on all diocesan parish websites with a focus on those specifically hosted on the digital faith platform. A goal by 2020 is that each parish will have an informational and aesthetically pleasing website.
